

January 2018 - Year 6 Curriculum Letter Spring 1st Half Term 2018

Dear parents,

Happy New Year to you all; I hope you have had a great Christmas.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for my lovely presents: THANK YOU!

With the year 6 tests getting closer, we are continuing to concentrate on our Maths and English learning. This half term in Maths we are continuing to practice all 4 calculations and learn more about the order of operations. Furthermore we are learning about angle rules and how to calculate angles, including the use of a protractor. Other areas we are going to explore are Statistics, Co-ordinates and measures.

In English we will be exploring and writing performance poetry, Stories with Flashbacks and Tales from other Cultures. We will also carry on learning more about grammar and spelling rules.

In Science this half term, we will learn about living things and their habitats. The children are going to explore how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals.

In RE, the children will be continuing to explore ideas within Buddhism as well as Christianity, focusing on how faith is expressed through art, drama, film and song.

The children will of course carry on with Game on as well as being taught music by Herts Music service. Computing as well as Art will be incorporated into our topic and science work. The children will carry on learning French and PSHE too.

Please support your child in delivering the homework to a good standard as well as practising their mental Maths.
