Dear Families of Year 4,

I hope that you all had an enjoyable half term holiday. This will be a busy and exciting half term, with World Book Day, Modern Foreign Languages Day, Easter and Science Week.

Our whole school theme this half term is 'Famous Faces' which will link in with our History topic on the Victorians. As part of our topic we will have a Victorian Day on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> March. Further details on this will follow.

In Maths, the children will be continuing to work on key skills of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at measures of length and weight and continuing with the 'Blast Off!' times tables work and problem solving using bar modelling.

In English, we will be integrating our History topic by using some Victorian stories, both fact and fiction, to inspire high quality writing. We will be continuing to study spelling and grammar and to work on achieving and maintaining neat, joined handwriting.
