


## Changes.

### Literacy

We have already begun reading Bog Baby and will read Tadpoles promise. We are now working on the children attempting sentences and stories. We are working on story maps to help us form these stories. We are also looking at News.



## Numeracy

Number songs and games are vital and are so useful to help your children become familiar with number recognition.



This term we shall be consolidating all our skills and using those to problem solve.

Nursery is encouraged to think about what number means and see it in real life experiences.

## Understanding of the World
